Dear Sir/Madam, **Town Club extended Hours**

I wish to object to the proposed increase in the already too long opening hours

Proposed for the Ryde Town Club in Star Street

.This would entail in increase in the presently high noise levels felt locally, and particularly in the back of No. [Redacted] where in spite of the Council ruling that the

door between the "music" room and the retrospectively permitted "Smoking Shelter" is, against council requirements, left open. Seating is provided in the Shelter (against regulations) so that the membership may rest, drink and listen to the music , again to the annoyance of locals

Longer opening will inevitably be highly disturbing (as it is at present) and mean more noise and foul unhealthy secondary smoke to enter No. [Redacted] bedroom, at present level quite healthily unacceptable.

With longer hours to further disturb the neighbourhood there woul inevitably be an increase in drunks, many of whom now drink canned beers lying down on the pavement outside the club. As is required by the council, there is generally no club committee member on the door to regulate ingress and egress in an orderly way, in fact the club seems to ignore all laws and regulations that are made to make the neighbourhood a decent place to live. All for money!

The requested increase in licensing hours should be denied, and due to the Non compliance with council regulations both music and alcohol licences should be revoked for good.
