There is insufficient information on this application. The scant details provided give rise to concerns about potential risks posed by this event. Numerous attempts have been made to contact the applicant on the phone number given and via e-mail. Messages have been left but we have been unable to make contact with the applicant and have not heard back from him.

Police are concerned as to what measures will be put in place to limit numbers to the 300 specified on the application.

Will this be a ticketed event and if so will tickets be sold prior to the event, on the gate or both?

What counting method will be used?

How will people be prevented from simply entering this normally open area, do they intend to use barriers to secure the area?

Will SIA accredited security be used during the event or are stewards to be used? How many of each?

Is it the intention of the applicant to use glassware or have a policy preventing glassware from being brought on to the site?

Who will be staffing the bar and are they experienced? Have they received sufficient training to ensure that drunks and those under 18 years old do not get sold alcohol. Will they be operating a 'challenge 21' policy?

What sort of entertainment is being provided and is it likely to give rise to crime and disorder/public nuisance?

How will the applicant ensure that children are kept from harm - what will be their policy on the admission of children to the site and/or to the bars and will the entertainment pose a risk to them?

Without further information the police are unable to support this application at this time.

Police recommendations (including any conditions)

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Barriers to be used to enclose the event site and allow one point of access. Staff controlling this entrance to use 'clickers' to record numbers. No children on site unless accompanied by an adult. Children to be supervised at all times. No children in the beer tent. A suitable number of stewards/SIA to be used during the event to prevent crime and disorder, ensure event numbers are kept within limits and ensure children are supervised at all times. All drinks to be served in plastic/polycarbon vessels and no bottles/glasses to be allowed on site. Personal licence holder to manage the bar and 'Challenge 21' policy to be operated. More recommendations may be necessary upon disclosure of further event information.
