

Newport Parish Council representation

Our Members considered this application at their last meeting on 22nd January and concluded that they wished to object to this particular site on the basis that local residents already suffer extensive inconvenience and loss of amenity during the Festival.

This factor, in combination with the proposed times for live/recorded music and supply of alcohol, persuaded the Committee to oppose to the application and suggest that the promoters of the event look for an alternative site.

Members view is that the proposed use will contravene the specific licensing objective to 'prevent public nuisance' for local residents and this comes about because of extending inconvenience, noise in the small hours, threat of anti-social activity, loss of amenity due to vehicle movement etc
