Dear Andrea

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on these public objections. I note the following concerns raised: music noise, customer noise whilst outside and also leaving, and littering. There have been no complaints over these issues with the exception of a complaint over a one off incident which I raised in my memo.

The timings for music applied for are exempt any restrictions under Licensing legislation as a result of the Live Music Act and Legislative Reform (Entertainment Licensing) Order 2014. However, Environmental Health has powers to abate any statutory nuisance under the Environmental Protection Act 1990. A review of the Licence could also be considered in that situation, where the Committee would have the option of including restrictions on the Licence.

With regards to customer noise whilst stood outside and leaving, I believe the proposed condition included in my memo of 20/5/15, can effectively control this noise. This would encourage customers wishing to stay after 23:00 to stay inside, where due to the size of the premises numbers would be restricted.

Environmental Health have no reports of any current problems of littering associated with the Beach Shack. Therefore, it is not necessary at this stage to recommend a condition requiring it be controlled (e.g. Bins, collections, monitoring). This will be reviewed should complaints be received however.
