The first time we used the Beachside Club (the day we moved in) we were required to sign the visitors book and were told that if we intended to use the facilities regularly we would have to become members; we subsequently did pay for membership. The club is mainly used by the residents of the site, their visiting relatives, a few other regular members who are local to the community, and holiday makers resident on the site temporarily. In the more than four months we have lived here and used the club, we have witnessed no altercations on or near the premises, we have not been troubled by any noise or disturbance that could be contributed to the club (our bedroom windows are in quite close proximity to the front of the premises), and we have not suffered any damage or litter that could have come from the club. We have always found all of the staff co-operative, polite, and caring, and even my wife has no qualms about going in to the club by herself. Having read the police application, I feel that they are pursuing the review far more aggressively than is warranted, to the extent of sending officers to each residence soliciting adverse (or possibly favourable?) responses. Is possibly the police have other agendas in wishing to limit the hours, ie saving costs?
