## Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 Rocket Ronnies, 4 Chain Lane, Newport, Isle of Wight PO30 5QA

I confirm that I have received a copy of an application for a Premises Licence in respect of the first floor of the above premises.

I would notify you that the Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service (the Fire and Rescue Authority) have attempted to contact the applicant by leaving telephone messages and by leaving contact details personally at the premises with no response resulting in an inspection not being carried out. However, I would comment that the means of escape and exit facilities from the first floor does not appear to be satisfactory at ground floor level when examining existing fire service plans and therefore this Authority would object to this application at this time.

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 places a duty on the responsible person to take general fire precautions by means of a suitable and sufficient **Fire Risk Assessment** to ensure the safety of all relevant persons and to remedy any findings of the assessment.

- Standards of fire performance for surface linings, curtains, drapes and furnishings.
- Evidence and recording of maintenance, tests and training in relation to Fire Safety

The Fire Risk Assessment should be conducted by a suitably competent person.

The premises may be inspected in due course in accordance with the Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service risk-based inspection programme.
