APPENDIX G

Agreed Police Conditions for 1st Floor, 4 Chain Lane, Newport, Isle of Wight, PO30 5QA.

1. At least two SIA registered door supervisors shall be present at any time when licensable activities are being provided for events which are likely to continue after 23:00 hours. They shall be present from the beginning of the event and shall remain on the premises until the time of closure.

2. At least two SIA registered door supervisors shall be present at any time when events are held where persons under the age of 18 are in attendance.

3. The number of door supervisors to be engaged on any other occasion shall be determined by the licence holder, taking into account such factors as the nature and duration of licensable activities proposed, the number, age and character of persons likely to attend, and any known risks to impact on the promotion of the licensing objectives. The licence holder shall make a written record of the number of door supervisors to be engaged and the factors taken into account by the licence holder. Any such record shall be produced to a police officer or authorised officer of the local authority on reasonable request.

4. No licensable activity shall be permitted by this licence until details of the CCTV system are submitted to, and agreed in writing by the local authority. Such details shall include the position, coverage, maintenance and technical specification and shall be maintained and operating in accordance with the details approved. The CCTV shall operate at all times when the premises are open for licensable activities and for at least 30 minutes thereafter. Recorded images will be retained for a minimum of 30 days. Such images will be made available to the police or licensing authority on request.

5. No person will be permitted to take or remove alcoholic or other drinks from the premises in open containers

6. All persons engaged in the sale of alcohol shall receive training or instruction to prevent the sale to anyone who is drunk or apparently under the age of 18 years. Such training will also include the details of the Premises Licence as well as its conditions. Staff members shall receive such training on induction, also at intervals not greater than one year apart. A record shall be made of;-

- the date the training or instruction was delivered,
- its content, and
- the names of the members of staff who received it.

The record shall be produced to a police officer or an authorised officer from the local authority on reasonable request.

7. A written record shall be made of every incident of crime and disorder taking place on the premises, to include any action taken by staff. Every entry in the record shall be signed and dated by the person making it. This record shall be produced to a police officer or an authorised officer of the local authority on reasonable request.

8. A written record shall be made of every refusal to sell alcohol to a person who is drunk or apparently aged under 18 years. Each entry shall be signed and dated by the person making it. The record shall be checked and counter signed by the DPS on at least a weekly basis and shall be produced to a police officer or authorised officer of the local authority on reasonable request.

9. The "Challenge 25" scheme will be adopted at the point of the sale of alcohol.

10. Where the premises are open for the sale of alcohol, entry will only be permitted to persons of 18 years or over.

11. No adult entertainment or burlesque shall be provided on the premises.

12. Toilet facilities are to be provided within the premises.

13. A designated smoking area is to be provided. It will be the responsibility of the D.P.S. to ensure that no more than 5 customers are permitted to use the smoking area at any one time.
