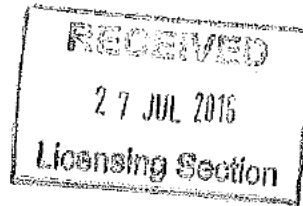

To the licencing officer,

I have applied for a change of vehicle on the 26th july 2016.

Replacing vehicle HW 07 EUU with vehicle HW 13 FUV .This vehicle at the moment is registered as private hire with the council as it seems it is not the right shade of silver.My private hire plate and door transfers on said vehicle lists make,registration no,but no colour as it cannot state silver as the registration docs state it is. If so is the above vehicle legal? As all vehicles are required to state colour of vehicle on licence plate for identification, and it must be the colour stated in registration document.

In the past when trying to register new vehicles with the council I have been told if the registration documents do not list the vehicle as silver it cannot be registered as a hackney vehicle.

HW 13 FUV was sold to me by Ford and its registration doc,s state it is silver.

I have since been told it is not the right shade of silver .Could you please supply me with your official colour chart that the council use on deciding what is the right shade of silver when granting a licence,As it cannot be down to the officer inspecting the vehicle on the day!.As there are many shades of silver from different manufactures and I would like to see if my shade is or not on your list. I will of course be prepared to pay for this copy if necessary .

I hope this application is successful as to save having to appeal, and as I have been told this will incur going to court, which I am prepared to do if necessary.

Could you let me know if there is a charge for your colour chart as I will need it if not successful with my application
