**Written Question from Mr. Dave Miller of Cowes to Cllr Ian Ward – Cabinet Member for Infrastructure and Transport**

**QUESTION**

*‘Further to the response provided at the last cabinet meeting, it was disappointing to observe that the council’s “slight oversight” in specifying and commissioning parking machines that charged for non-chargeable hours, has continued for months, with a parking machine on Cowes parade still erroneously advising ‘Charges apply at all times’ (photographed 28/08/17 – disproving the claim of the responsible member in his response to PQ10/17). Does the Council not have the capacity to satisfactorily operate parking schemes and manage information?’*
