















Consultation response analysis

School/College responses

- Retention of present 11-16 provision with adjusted sizes
- Retention of present post-16 A-level provision

(Sandown and Ryde working co-operatively 350 post-16 learners across the two schools)

- PSBP1 Ryde/Carisbrooke/Christ the King
- Funding envelope = 30 forms of entry 11-16
- PSBP2 Sandown



Consultation response analysis

11-16 proposed size of PSBP1 schools Option 1 Ryde 10fe Medina 9fe (not in PSBP1) Christ the King 9fe Carisbrooke 23fe Option 2a (merged on the Carisbrooke site) Ryde Christ the King 9fe 30fe Option 2b (merged on the Medina site) 10fe Christ the King 9fe 30fe (but only 21fe required through PSBP1)
