## REPORT FROM THE EXECUTIVE MEMBER FOR ADULT SOCIAL CARE AND INTEGRATION TO THE MEETING OF FULL COUNCIL ON WEDNESDAY, 15 JUNE 2016

The current financial pressures on the system as a whole (trust, clinical commissioning group, local authority) means the agenda for integration of health and social care is now more urgent than ever. We are being asked to deliver 'efficiencies' in year and the system redesign modelling work presently underway will present us with a template for change in service delivery. I would urge all members to attend the briefings in relation to this, as it is likely to have significant impact upon our residents and will generate much debate as we move towards consultation and eventual implementation.

I have been very encouraged by recent developments in the operational element of adult social care, but I recognise the requirement to remain vigilant, as increasing costs in this area continues to be a real concern.
