

APPENDIX 2

ITEMS TO BE DISCUSSED WITH POST ELECTION ADMINISTRATION

1. Items identified by the Constitution Working Party:
 - a. Providing officer support to members for “ward work”.
 - b. Commencement time of meetings.
 - c. Whether we continue with the Select Committees.
 - d. Future of the Employment Committee.
 - e. Separating out the “civic” role of the Chairman from the chairing of the Council meetings.
2. Other issues that may be considered for discussion with an incoming administration include:
 - a. Listing certain Executive portfolios that have to exist (ie Childrens, Adult Social Care, Resources and Regeneration) these could be part of other portfolios.
 - b. Number of full council meetings in any year.
 - c. Re-instatement of Executive member delegated decisions (abolished by the current administration).
 - d. Clarity on involvement of full council in the appointment of Chief Officers (in law the Head of Paid Service is a Council appointment but at moment our constitution is unclear but seems to suggest that Section 151 Officer and Monitoring Officer are also appointments of full council).
 - e. Involvement of members in appeals by officers in respect of disciplinary and capability dismissals.
