## Response

The Local Authority has in place a number of dog control orders across a number of beaches across the Island. These Dog Control orders have been in place for a number of years and will be due for a review in 2018 when the local authority looks to go out to public consultation on the introduction of new Public Spaces Protection Orders (replacing existing Dog Control Orders).
