## **Summary**

This funding update is provided to illustrate the estimated development of the funding position from 31 March 2016 to 31 March 2018, for the Isle of Wight Council Pension Fund ("the Fund"). It is addressed to Isle of Wight Council in its capacity as the Administering Authority of the Fund and has been prepared in my capacity as your actuarial adviser.

At the last formal valuation the Fund assets were £474m and the liabilities were £518m. This represents a deficit of £44m and equates to a funding level of 91.5%. Since the valuation the funding level has decreased by 1.9% to 89.6% as detailed in the table above.


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


