Decision taken	Option 2: To approve the proposed restrictions that are subject to this report in relation to The Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Ryde) (Traffic Regulation) Order No 1 2019 and associated orders – The Isle of Wight Council (Designated Loading Bays) Order No 1 2019; The Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Ryde, IW) (One Way Traffic) Order No 1 2019; The Isle of Wight (Disabled Drivers' Street Parking Places) Order No 1 2019; The Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Ryde, Isle of Wight) (Prohibition of Driving) Order No 1 2019
Reason for decision	<p>Following concerns raised locally in relation to parked vehicles blocking pavement, forcing pedestrians onto the carriageway and causing access issues for emergency vehicles in Ryde Town Centre, a review of the current traffic management confirmed that changes are required to aid traffic flow and improve road safety in the area.</p> <p>The Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Ryde) (Traffic Regulation) Order No 1 2019 has been promoted under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the following reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; • Preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic in a manner which is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road and adjoining properties; • Improving the air quality in the town centre through reduced nitrogen oxides, emitted into the atmosphere; • Preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; • Allowing access for emergency vehicles 24 hours seven days a week.

Additional reasons	In line with the council's Corporate Plan, the proposed amendments to the existing shared use into a 'Pedestrian Only Zone' at these locations link in with the corporate priority to keep the island and its residents safe and enhance the amenities/characteristics.
