<b>Reference</b>	14/19	
<b>Notice of Decision Published</b>	Friday, 6 September 2019	
<b>Decision taken</b>	To approve the fee level for Fixed Penalty Notices for breach of Community Protection Notices and set the fee level at £100 or £75 if paid for within 14 days.	
<b>Reason for decision</b>	<p>The option to offer an alternative to prosecution is in line with the Neighbourhoods Enforcement Policy where there is a graduated approach to enforcement and an option to accept responsibility by the offender and discharge the offence. This is consistent with other enforcement options such as a simple caution.</p> <p>This will not replace prosecution but is seen as a useful tool in some cases.</p>
