<b>Decision taken</b>	To adopt the Licensing Boat/Boatman Policy as outlined in Appendix A of the report.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The council does not currently have an active policy in place which details the requirements and processes for a person to apply for and acquire either a boatman or boat licence. It is important that clear and concise guidance is available to applicants, surveyors and licensing officers to ensure a consistent approach is maintained when issuing a licence.
