Questions received from Members	Questions were received from the Ward Member seeking clarification around travel arrangements, the future use of Yarmouth School site, where children will be accommodated on the Yarmouth site, what will happen to the pre-school on the All Saints site, what are the current building plans for All Saints, confirmation of the Education and Skills Funding Agency (EFSA) funding commitment, the dates of the two public school meetings, how will children of the new school take part in community events in the two Parishes, would it not make more sense to move all children to All Saints temporarily, could the early years centre be extended for some or all of the primary school years. The Ward member indicated that these questions may be better considered at a meeting, and the Cabinet member has agreed to meet with the Ward Member in due course to respond to these questions in so far as they can be answered at this stage of the consultation.
