Decision taken	To approve the proposed calendar for term dates 2020/21 as set out in Appendix 1 of the report.
Reason for decision	The proposed calendar has been carefully considered in light of the change that applied for 2019/2020 and in consultation with schools. Having considered the above, it is felt that the option in Appendix 1 is the most suitable.
Additional reasons	Schools have had opportunity to comment on the proposed school day and have supported the design.
Options considered and rejected	There has been careful consideration to the proposed calendar 2020/21. The majority of neighbouring authorities will be consulting, or have consulted, on a very similar calendar although IoW uniquely has a two week October half term holiday.
