THE BAY CE PRIMARY SCHOOL, SANDOWN ALTERATION TO THE UPPER AGE LIMIT OF THE SCHOOL

- Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 19 (3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, that the Governing Body of The Bay Church of England (CE) Primary School, Winchester Park Rd, Sandown PO36 9BA intends to make prescribed alterations to **The Bay CE Primary School** by altering the upper age limit of the school to become a voluntary controlled all-through school through the utilisation of Sandown Bay Academy site and buildings. The all-through school will cater for boys and girls irrespective of ability, aged 4 – 16, with effect from 1 September 2018.
- Places will be available for all pupils affected by the closure of Sandown Bay Academy (including those with special educational needs) at the all-through 4-16 Church of England school. The transport entitlement will continue to be decided by the Local Authority's home to school transport policy.
 - 3. The all-through CE school will cater for pupils between the ages of 4 and 16 and have a total capacity for 1620 pupils. For the 2018/19 academic year, the school will admit up to 60 pupils at Year R and 180 pupils at Year 7. All Year 6 pupils at the all-through school will be able to transfer automatically to Year 7 if they wish, however, additional Year 7 places will be offered if fewer than 60 children transfer to Year 7, so that the total number of children starting Year 7 is 240. Pupils will be admitted to the school in accordance with published admissions policies.
