Reason for decision	<p>To support the action agreed as a result of the car park strategy and therefore help further support any future reports on the implementation of RPZ's.</p> <p>The introduction of RPZ's are very controversial and it is therefore important that the public and stakeholders get the opportunity to influence the process before any implementation is considered</p>
Additional reasons	Implementing the parking strategy is a key activity in the council's corporate plan and this is the first in a series of decisions that will ensure delivery of the strategy.
