As a result of the proposed cut of stroke support, stroke survivors will not get specialist support for their new complex disabilities, what assessment has been made of the impact on other adult social care service budgets and resources due to increased demand?

Response

Stroke Survivors will continue to receive specialist clinical Support. The clinical needs of those affected by stroke are the responsibility of the NHS Trust and they will continue to meet these needs. Our initial assessment indicates that there is likely to be limited impact on other Adult social care services as stroke survivors are usually already supported by these other services. We have made an approach to the Integrated Care System to consider alternative funding streams and are awaiting a response.
