Title: Weight Management Spend		
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What is asked of Management Team:

1. To agree the additional spend for IOW Tier 2 Weight Management (T2WM) services, recurring for five years commencing 1 July 2023.

Background

- 2. Papers have been received by QPMT in May and September 2022 reporting contractual remedial measures imposed due to under-performance of the tier two weight management service provided by Solutions 4 Health (S4H). The provider gave formal notification that the service was not financially sustainable at the budget level of £32,500 per annum.
- **3.** As a result of this situation a full tender exercise is being carried out to procure a new provider with a contract start date of 1 July 2023.
- **4.** A costing model has been developed collaboratively by Hampshire and Isle of Wight T2WM commissioners which when applied to IOW need (based on NICE Guidance) incurs a cost pressure requiring an increase of the T2WM budget recurring over the life of the contract, namely five years.
- **5.** The purpose of this paper is to update Management Team on costs and ask for approval to increase the T2WM contract budget for the next five years commencing 1 July 2023.

Context

- **6.** From the needs assessment carried out in 2019 The estimated number of people that may be eligible for Level 2 services on the Isle of Wight is 49,335. However, a small proportion of these people will be ready to change their lifestyle and are in want of support. Assuming this applies to 1.5% of the population (NICE guidance), a level 2 service might expect to have sufficient capacity for 740 people a year.
- **7.** Table 1 shows the cost of the existing contract, proposed new costs and the difference (cost pressure) between them:

might lead to a failed tender or selection of another provider who cannot then deliver the required level of activity and quality of service.
