**RECORD OF EXECUTIVE DECISION – DEPUTY LEADER OF THE CABINET**

**Title of Matter:** Community Occupational Therapy Service and Support Arrangements – Grant of delegated authority to the Director of Adult Social Care and Community Well-being

**Decision maker:** Cllr Ian Stephens, Deputy Leader of the Cabinet

**Power(s) giving authority to make an executive decision:** Section 9GB and para. 2(7) of Schedule A1 to the Local Government Act 2000 (where the Leader is unable to act, the deputy leader must act in the Leader's place) and Section 9E (2) of the Local Government Act 2000 (Discharge of functions: general) and under all other enabling powers.

**Decision:** That the Director of Adult Social Care and Community Wellbeing be granted full delegated authority, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Adult Social Care and Public Health, to determine the provision of a community occupational therapy service and support, including incidental matters relating to such provision.

**Date of decision:** 2 May 2023

**Reason for decision:** The local authority is required under the Care Act 2014 to ensure that such community occupation therapy service is made available. The existing arrangements are due to cease on 30 September 2023 and future arrangements are needed to be made. The grant of delegated authority will enable such arrangements to be put in place.
