UPCOMING DELEGATED DECISION NOTICE – FOOD HYGIENE INSPECTION
PROGRAMME

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”)

Notice is hereby given that the Cabinet Member(s) for Regulatory Services, Community Protection and ICT intends no earlier than 26 January 2024 to make an executive decision regarding the Food Hygiene Inspection Programme.

Under the requirements of Regulation 9 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, the Council is required to give 28 days’ notice of a key decision identified within the scope of these regulations.
