3.	Reason(s) for the decision:	Wight Shipyard currently occupies the main part of the Columbine Building. The company is a subsidiary of a French shipbuilding company and there is a need for a direct 'fibre' ICT link between the facilities, to improve communications. This requires a server room as close to the Castle Street frontage as possible, which is separate from the manufacturing parts of the building, and which can be securely occupied. A small windowless room on the ground floor, adjacent to the Wight Shipyard demise, has been identified and terms agreed to grant a Tenancy at Will at £300.00 pax. IWC is currently in negotiations with Wight Shipyard for additional accommodation within the Columbine Building and it is envisaged that when a new lease is agreed the server room will be added to that demise and the Tenancy at Will will terminate.
4.	Details of any alternative options considered and rejected by the officer when making the decision:	The server room needs to be at the Castle Street frontage and at ground floor level to facilitate the easiest possible fibre access. The only other ground floor space that could be securely occupied is a former electricity substation. This is less suitable as it has external access only, and it does not physically adjoin the Wight Shipyard demise. Other than the substation, the only potentially available accommodation is on upper floors, which are better suited to manufacturing, office use, or storage, and which are less accessible to a direct fibre link.
