**UPCOMING DELEGATED DECISION NOTICE – MICROMOBILITY CONTRACT
FOR THE SOLENT AND E-SCOOTER TRIAL EXTENSION**

**The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to
Information) (England) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”)**

Notice is hereby given that the Leader and Cabinet Member for Transport and Infrastructure, Highways PFI and Transport Strategy intends no earlier than **19 April 2024** to make an executive decision regarding the Micromobility Contract for the Solent and E-Scooter Trial Extension.

Under the requirements of Regulation 9 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, the Council is required to give 28 days’ notice of a key decision identified within the scope of these regulations.

It is considered the item referred to above would be a key decision and it has been duly advertised on the Council Forward Plan for the requisite 28 clear calendar days. This notice is to advise that the Cabinet Member(s) intends to make a decision no earlier than **19 April 2024**.
