**UPCOMING DELEGATED DECISION NOTICE – Proposed Parking Restrictions
in Appley Rise and Amphill Road, Ryde**

**The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to
Information) (England) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”)**

Notice is hereby given that the Cabinet Member for Transport and Infrastructure Highways PFI and Transport Strategy intends no earlier than 22 July 2024 to make an executive decision regarding Proposed Parking Restrictions in Appley Rise and Amphill Road, Ryde.

Under the requirements of Regulation 9 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, the Council is required to give 28 days’ notice of a key decision identified within the scope of these regulations.

It is considered the item referred to above would be a key decision and it has been duly advertised on the Council Forward Plan for the requisite 28 clear calendar days.
