

The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order 2020 advertisement

THE ISLE OF WIGHT COUNCIL (PARKING PLACES) ORDER NO 2 2020

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1, 2, 4, 32, 35,

124(1)(d) and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Road Traffic Act 1991 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, propose to make an Order the effect of which will be:

1. To revoke the provisions of The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Consolidation Order No 1 2020.

2. To re-enact the provisions contained therein subject to the following amendments:

a) To revoke 'Pay and Display 1 March to 31 October' parking restriction and introduce 'Pay and Display'

only in the following lengths of road:

SANDOWN

Culver Parade, Sandown on the south-east side, from its junction with Fort Street to a point 82.5 metres thereof.

Culver Parade, Sandown on the south-east side, from a point 28 metres south-west to a point 158.5 metres south-west of its junction with Fort Street.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the south-east side, from a point 15 metres south-west to a point 177 metres

south-west of its junction with Avenue Slipway.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the south-east side, from a point 5.5 metres north-east to a point 30.5 metres

north-east of its junction with Esplanade Road.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the south-east side, from a point 70 metres south-west to a point 121 metres

south-west of its junction with Esplanade Road.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the north-west side, from a point 77 metres south-west to a point 118 metres

south-west of its junction with Esplanade Road.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the south-east side, from a point 72 metres south-west to a point 122 metres

south-west of its junction with Esplanade Road.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the south-east side, from a point 24.5 metres north-east to a point 64.5 metres north-east of its junction with Battery Slip Way.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the south-east side, from a point 21 metres south-west to a point 64 metres south-west of its junction with Pier Street.

Esplanade, Sandown, on the south-east side, from a point 72.5 metres south-west to a point 141 metres south-west of its junction with Pier Street.

SHANKLIN

Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 74 metres south-west to a point 108.5 metres south-west of its junction with Hope Hill.

Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 120 metres south-west to a point 185 metres

south-west of its junction with Hope Hill.

Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 197 metres south-west to a point 299 metres

south-west of its junction with Hope Hill.

Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 312.5 metres south-west to a point 331.5 metres south-west of its junction with Hope Hill.

Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 344 metres south-west to a point 410 metres

south-west of its junction with Hope Hill.

Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 424.5 metres south-west to a point 440.5 metres south-west of its junction with Hope Hill.
Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 30 metres south-west to a point 48 metres south-west of its junction with Lift Road.
Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 80 metres south-west to a point 91 metres south-west of its junction with Lift Road.
Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 99 metres south-west to a point 179 metres south-west of its junction with Lift Road.
Esplanade, Shanklin, on the south-east side, from a point 187 metres south-west to a point 244 metres south-west of its junction with Lift Road.

VENTNOR

Esplanade, Ventnor, on the south side, from a point 45 metres east to a point 63 metres east of its junction with Esplanade Road.
Esplanade, Ventnor, on the south side, from a point 38.5 metres east to a point 10.5 metres west of its junction with Esplanade Road.
Esplanade, Ventnor, on the south side, from a point 23.5 metres west to a point 55.5 metres west of its junction with Esplanade Road.
Esplanade, Ventnor, on the south side, from a point 36.5 metres west to a point 54.5 metres west of its junction with Alma Road.
Esplanade, Ventnor, on the south side, from a point 3.5 metres west to a point 46 metres west of its junction with Alma Road.

COWES

Queens Road, Cowes, on the north side, from a point 4 metres east to a point 42 metres east of its junction with Egypt Hill.
Queens Road, Cowes, on the north side, from a point 53.5 metres east to a point 221 metres east of its junction with Egypt Hill.

b) To Introduce 'Pay and Display' in the following lengths of road with the following tariffs:

New Charge between 10am and 6pm

Up to 1 hour £1.70
1-2 hours £2.90
2-4 hours £4.80
4-6 hours £6.20
6-8 hours £8.60

All evenings

Between 6pm and 10am £1.00 per visit

Egypt Esplanade, Cowes, on the north-west side, for its entire length.
Princes Esplanade, Gurnard, north-west side, from its junction with Egypt Esplanade to a point 198 metres north of its junction with Woodvale Road.
Princes Esplanade, Gurnard, west side, from a point 188 metres north to a point 20 metres north of its junction with Woodvale Road.

c) To Introduce 'Pay and Display' in the following area with the charge listed below:

Somerton Park and Ride Car Park, Cowes:

New Charge

24 hours £2.00

The amendments are being proposed to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;

A copy of the draft Order, this Notice and the relevant plan may be inspected between normal office hours at the Customer Service Centre, County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight during the objection period.
