The Chairman together with Cllrs Brodie, Mosdell, Spink and Quigley, Hewston and Weedall attended an initial workplan session on Wednesday, 30 June 2021.

As the result of this it is suggested that the previous workplan item dealing with monitoring the delivery of the Highway PFI and Waste Contracts should be included in the workplan for the Policy and Scrutiny Committee for Neighbourhoods and Regeneration.

The following topics were identified for possible inclusion the Corporate Scrutiny Committee's workplan :-

- a) Review of the Investment Strategy
- b) Review of the Capital Strategy
- c) Review of Income Generation Strategy

- d) Social value in purchasing arrangements
- e) One Public Service outcomes
- f) Planning and development of housing policies (joint work with the Policy and Scrutiny Committee for Neighbourhoods and Regeneration)
- g) Communication and Consultation
- h) Property disposals and the Asset Management Plan

It is intended that a scoping document will be drafted for each item with a view to these being submitted for approval at the Committee meeting on 7 September 2021. This will enable key lines of enquiry to be outlined, evidence/data required, method of approach, timeframe and resources required.

The Committee will also use the Financial Scrutiny Practice Guide, issued in June 2020 by the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA) and the Centre for Public Scrutiny (CfPS), as the basis for ongoing scrutiny of the council's finances and budget.
