What is the Modern.Gov app?

The Modern.Gov app (often referred to as the mod.gov app) provides electronic access to the Isle of Wight Council's agendas, reports and minutes and is available on the following types of mobile device:

- iPad
- Android
- Windows

Once downloaded, the app will appear on your tablet screen and will automatically download any committee documents whenever you open it.

The app allows you to highlight sections of the agenda pack and make annotations just as you would with a paper copy. Document navigation is made quick and simple via bookmarking and intuitive controls.

The app also allows you to have access to exempt sections of the agendas via password protected access to the 'restricted app'. Further information on this and how you can register for this can be gained from Democratic Services.

Operating System

Compatibility will depend on the operating system used. The modern.gov app runs on iOS11 and higher (so most iPads). Android Tablets with a system 6.0 or higher (covers most modern Android devices). In regard to Windows devices, it should be running Windows 10+.

It is recommended any device has at least 8GB of RAM storage and that the minimum screen size is 10" with Full HD Definition.
