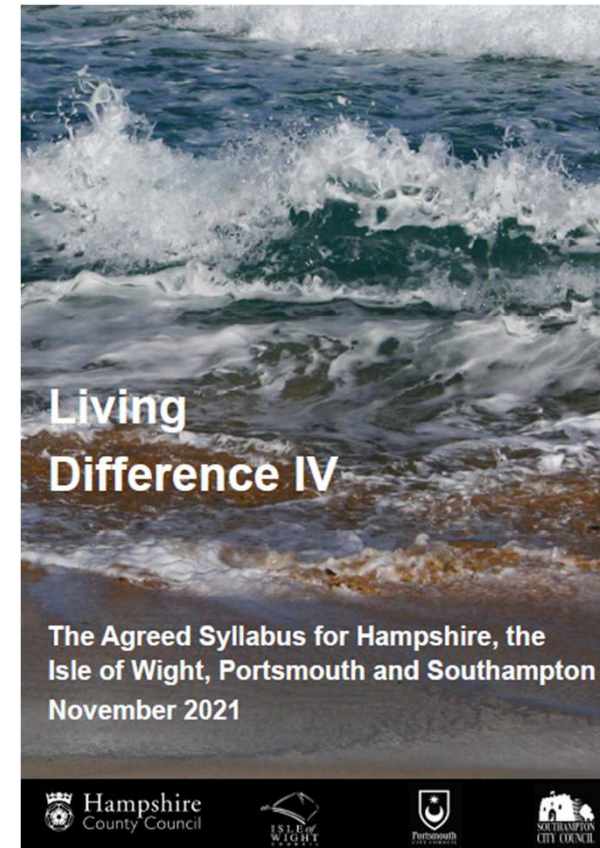


# R.E. on the Isle of Wight

- The IoW Locally Agreed Syllabus : Living Difference IV
- The constructive relationship for R.E. with Hampshire, Portsmouth and Southampton Local Authorities, which has resulted in the revised Locally Agreed Syllabus, Living Difference IV, being adopted for use in IoW Schools in October 2021
- This presentation will cover the support available to teachers on the Isle of Wight for R.E.
- The implementation of the Locally Agreed Syllabus Living Difference IV over the coming two terms.

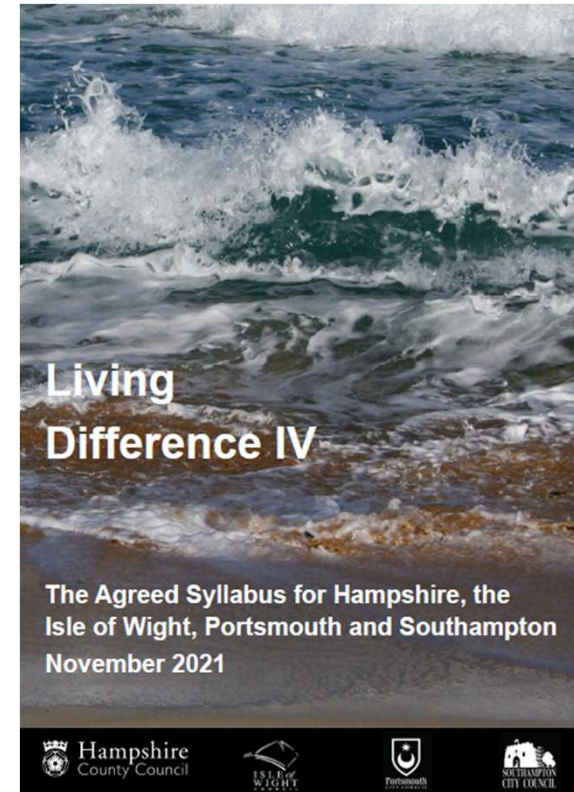
- Autumn 2019: Teacher questionnaire
- January 2020: Teacher focus group
- Spring 2020: Agreed Syllabus Conference(s) (ASC)
- July 2020: Joint SACRE meeting
- July 2020-July 2021: revision process with teachers
- July 2021: Joint SACRE meeting
- Summer 2021 finishing and completing Publisher doc.
- October 2021: ASC to adopt Living Difference IV
- 30 November 2021: launch of Living Difference IV



# Living Difference IV

‘The Living Difference Approach to RE v4’

- Clear **purpose statement**
- Clear **process for teaching RE**
- Clear **explanation** how to make curriculum
- Clear advice to teachers how to ensure children ***progress*** over time



# Resourcing and supporting R.E. on the Isle of Wight



Regular termly online network meetings for RE leaders run by the Hampshire Primary RE Inspector/adviser and the Hampshire Secondary RE Inspector/adviser.

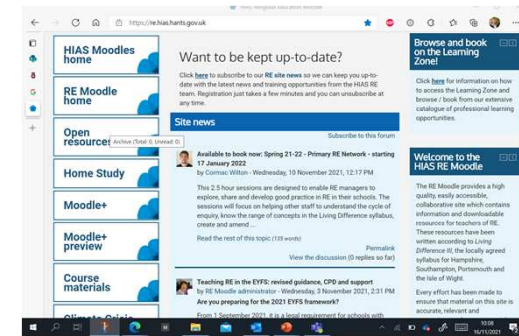
These are well attended and cover:

- best practice for teaching and curriculum making with the Locally Agreed Syllabus for RE , Living Difference IV
- Ofsted requirements (including advice on the May 2021 Ofsted Research Review on R.E.)
- assessment, monitoring and review of the syllabus.

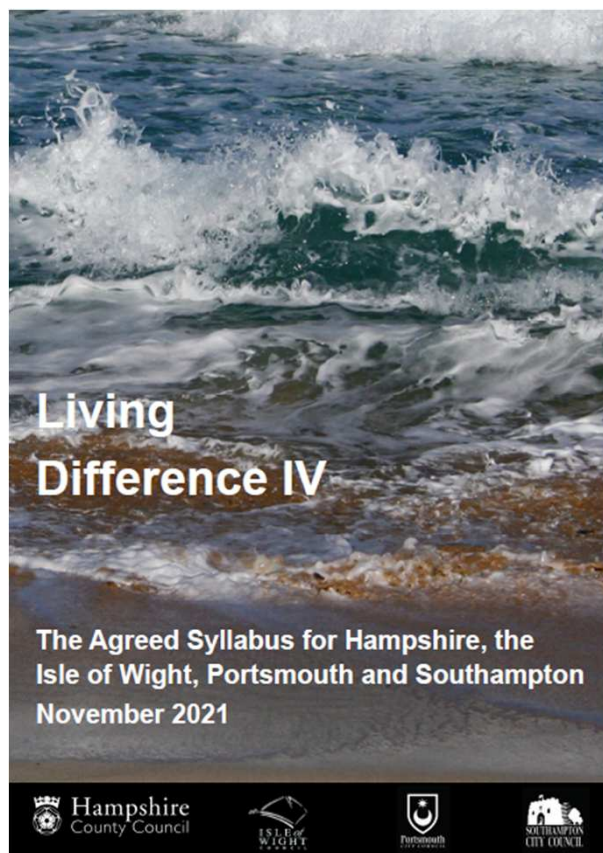
Advisers are also available for one to one support, via email, face to face visits and training in school or virtual visits through 'Teams' and through receiving (free) regular R.E. e-news.
