Decision: That the discretionary scheme (as set out Appendix 1 to the attached report) to allocate £150 to those eligible residents to support them with the rising costs of energy bills be agreed and implemented.

Reason for decision: To assist eligible residents on low incomes who will not be eligible for a payment under the mandatory scheme to ensure they also receive £150 to assist with rising energy costs.
