The revised plan completely ignores the overwhelming opposition from local Freshwater residents and Freshwater Parish Council and the settlement boundary has moved when there is overwhelming evidence of NO support from the local community, Island Roads, or the police and the council rushing is through with this plan now, when national guidance is changing this summer, while at the same time the council is ignoring advice from the council's own Task & Finish Group - on these points, is this fair or legal?
